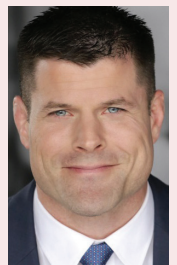

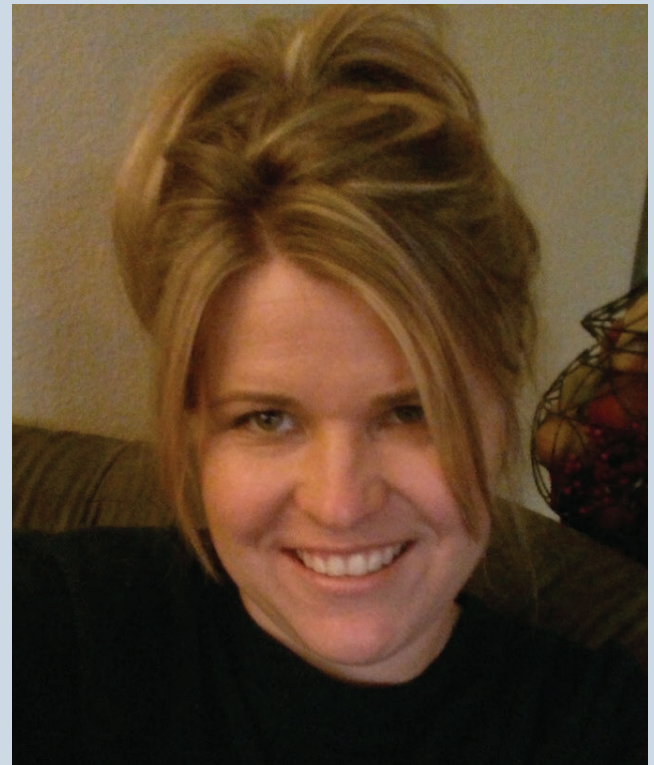

WHERE IS MY PACKAGE?

Are you missing some important mail? Did you get a notification that your package was delivered by USPS, but you cannot find it? Unfortunately, we have received multiple complaints about this very thing happening to our AFMAC residents. The good news is that USPS is here to help. If you ever have mail or a package go missing or miss a delivery, please take the following steps as the local USPS wants to ensure they address this quickly:

- Contact your USPS Postmaster at USAFA at (719) 472-0537 immediately to make them aware of the situation.
- Provide the tracking number of the package or mail piece.
- And again, **REPORT IT IMMEDIATELY** when it happens at (719) 472-0537.

The local USPS asked us to send a friendly reminder when someone is sending a package or mail to your home, to ensure the following is listed:

- Unit numbers
- If accepting packages from a nonresident at your home, it needs to state "in the care of," your name, and your AFAMC address.

LOOSE PETS

We have noticed an influx of calls and emails about loose pets throughout the community. As a friendly reminder to our pet owners, you must keep your pet restrained at all times when outside the home or fenced in your yard. If this continues to be a regular occurrence, the resident is at risk of having their pet privileges revoked and the pet removed from the community immediately.

PLEASE DRIVE ATTENTIVELY

Slow down when driving through the communities! While you may be in a rush to reach your destination, remember we have many younger residents playing and pedestrians walking in and around AFAMC. With spring break right around the corner, more individuals will be out and about within the community. Please drive at a safe speed and observe your surroundings.

DISHWASHER TIPS & TRICKS

As a part of your cleaning, it's important to do a little dishwasher maintenance. According to The Washington Post, this should be completed monthly to prevent a buildup of germs. Grab these common household items from the pantry and get started.

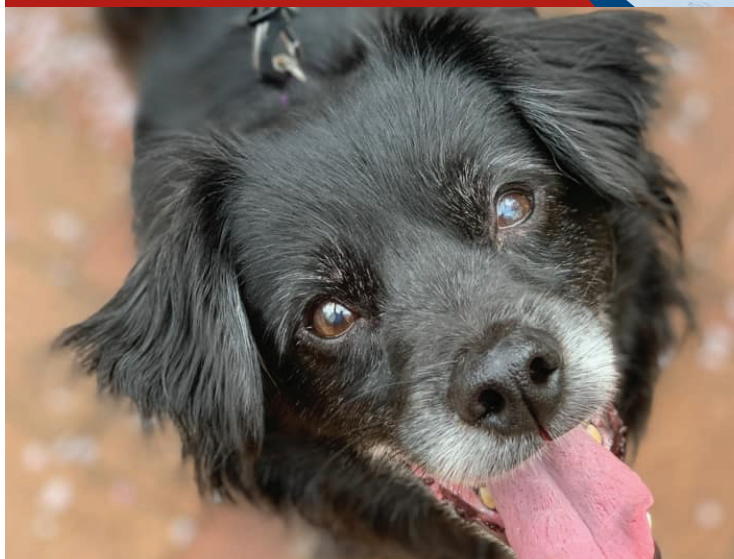
1. Run an empty dishwasher with white vinegar.

And just like that, your dishwasher will be as good as new! Remember, your dishwasher is a sanitizer and not responsible for doing all the hard work.



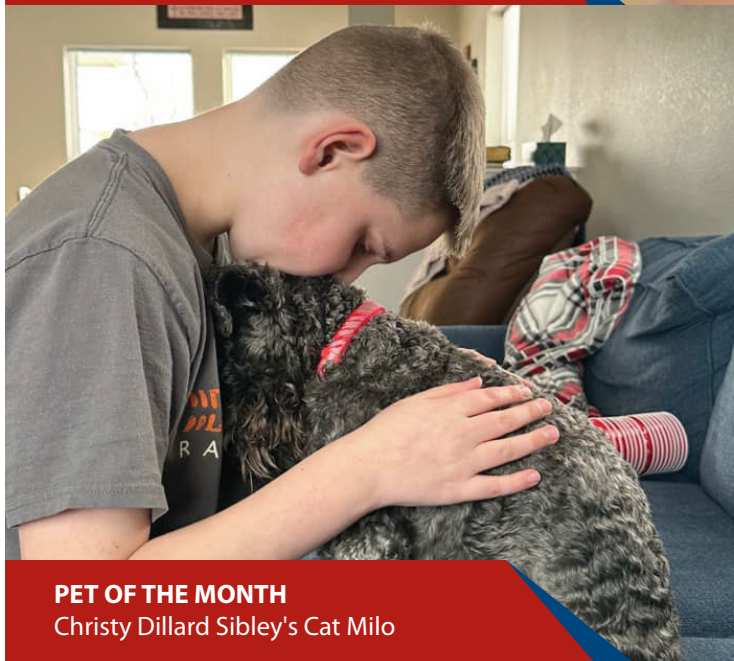
