If you need a replacement air filter at no charge, visit the Community Management Office during business hours to pick up a FREE air filter.

Be sure to test your smoke detectors and carbon monoxide sensors twice a month. We recommend doing this every payday, so you do not forget.

Look Up! We have crews working around housing this month installing new roofs on a number of houses around the AFA to bring additional improvements to the homes here.

## **MAINTENANCE CORNER**

Be Bear Aware! As you are enjoying your home, please be sure to think about bears, as they are present here at the AFA.
